How is Security handled?

- User badges Everyone in the mc² community receives a virtual "badge" identifying them in the Community.
 GDLS U.S. employee;
 GDLS-Canada employee;
 Members (aka Supplier);
 Foreign National.
- Password strength requirements For your protection, your password must meet security requirements.

Build a Strong Password: Lowercase letter (A-2) Uppercase letter (A-2) Vumeral (V-9) Punctuation or other (1@#8...) Minimum 8 characters Better with 8 or more characters

Do I need an iSupplier ID?

You do not require a GD Land Systems iSupplier IDs to register in mc². If you already have an iSupplier ID, we recommend you register with your iSupplier ID. Benefit: All of your company's members who register with your company's iSupplier ID will automatically be added to the same company group within mc². Note: please do not use your iSupplier ID as your user name.

How do "Private" and "Proprietary" Groups differ?

- "<Company name>"
 - > Security set to "Private" meant for public release data, to market your company to the GDLS employee base.
 - > Community members can find the Group in a Search, and can see content only if a member of the Group.
 - > Community members can request to be added to the Group, or they can be invited.
- "<Company name> Proprietary"
 - > Security set to "Hidden" The mc2 Screening and Matching Team is automatically added to your membership. This is meant for proprietary data related to Innovative Solutions.
 - > Community members can not find the Group unless they are members of the Group.
 - > Community members can only be invited to "Hidden" Groups.
